- Students who have a B or higher (not B -) in the course, will earn a waiver to the retesting requirement.

Success Tip:

Aim for a grade of B or higher in all classes!

The PreMajor Advantage

Opportunity to strengthen an area of weakness (Reading, Writing and/or Math) PRIOR to entering your program of study.

Opportunity to visit the Program of Study to observe a class and meet the instructor to confirm that you want to pursue this field.

Opportunity to get ahead on general education classes, leaving more time to focus on your program later.
